READ CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Welcome! On the other side of this paper, you will find instructions for logging into our web-based scheduling program to select your courses for next year. Begin:

- 1) **Make sure you have your completed Course Selection form and this paper.**
- 2) **Open your web browser to <http://wbcS.sjUSD.org>**
- 3) **Your ID is your student ID number and your PIN is your birthday (mmddyy). For example, if your birthday is April 5, 1994, you would enter 040594**
- 4) **When selecting preferred periods:**
 - No zero period - you do not want or cannot have a zero period
 - No 6th period - you do not want a 6th period. May get a zero period.
 - choosing nothing means anything you get is fine with you
- 5) **As you select your courses, always check the course number for accuracy.**
- 6) **All students are requested to select a minimum of 6 classes. You will only be allowed to select one math and one science course. If you choose fewer than 6, we will choose for you based on availability and transcript analysis.**
- 7) **If the Course Selection form says "Teacher Approval Required" and you sign up for the class without the approval, your course selection will be changed for you.**
- 8) **Complete each section on your computer screen as directed.**

AFTER YOU HAVE SELECTED ALL OF YOUR CLASSES, YOU MUST HIT "SUBMIT"

AND THEN "SAVE SUBMITTED" OR ALL OF YOUR COURSE SELECTIONS WILL BE WIPED OUT!

Please note:

- You are not scheduling your classes, you are only selecting the courses you would like to take. There is no right or wrong order for your selections.**
- If you do not have access to a computer, you may select your classes by using one of the computers in the Media Center or the Career Center.**
- The Web Scheduler will only be available to select courses or make changes on these dates and times...**

***Incoming 9th graders:**
