MISSION STATEMENT

The California Association of Latino Superintendents and Administrators (CALSA) is a community of educational leaders whose mission is working to increase the number of successful Latino/Latina administrators, committed to closing the Latino/Latina achievement gap.

CALSA seeks to fulfill its goal of “increasing the number of successful Latinos/Latinas” by offering scholarships to further the pursuit of higher education for Latino/a students. Each scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00 for the 2010-2011 academic school year.

CALSA Scholarship Recipients shall receive their award check upon providing an official college class schedule for the 2010 Fall Semester to the Scholarship Coordinator.

Screening and Selection Process:

A screening committee will read the applications and select the successful recipients. The final list of scholarship recipients will be submitted to the Executive Director by May 7, 2010.

Scholarship Application Time Line

- February through April 5th: Make available applications through CALSA website.
- April 5th will be the deadline for submission of 2010-2011 scholarships
- April 11th through May 1st selection committee reads and selects finalists.
- By May 14th notify successful candidates and their CALSA sponsors.
- Publish flyer announcing scholarship recipients and announce at the 2010 Summer Institute. Also place on website and list in the 2010 CALSA annual report.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be a Latino/Latina 2010 graduating high school senior in the district of a current CALSA member.
2. Must outline in their application examples of community service completed.
3. Must have a written recommendation from:
 - The superintendent of schools
 - One teacher and
 - The CALSA member sponsoring the applicant
4. Must submit a typed essay of 250 words or less on the following questions:

Where do you plan to attend college, what do you want to study and why?

How will your college education impact your life, family and community?

How will a college education assist you in making a contribution to your community?

Why should you be granted a CALSA scholarship?
5. Must submit a JPEG PIC and a set of current high school transcripts
