1. All juniors should plan to take at least one ACT and/or SAT Reasoning test and the required SAT Subject Tests if applying to UC's and selective colleges **by June**. We encourage you to take both SAT and ACT because colleges will take the best score and the tests are different.
2. Most schools will not consider test scores past December of your senior year. Keep in mind that these deadlines may change. In past years CSU Long Beach and San Diego strongly recommended testing completed by October (by Nov. Cal Poly, SLO). SDSU may not consider your December test scores. Check with independent schools for their deadlines.
3. Make sure that you have all your test scores **officially sent by SAT or ACT to every school to which you are applying by the college deadline (usually December)**. SAT Reports include the most recent scores for up to 6 SAT Reasoning and 6 SAT Subject Test administrations (you will have the option of signing up for "Score Choice" (free) where you choose which scores will be sent). ACT Reports only include the test date you request. You can report your SAT scores to **ALL CSU** campuses by using code **3594**. **Important: colleges may not consider your application if you do not send official test scores through the college board (SAT or ACT) to the college by their deadline.**
4. University of California campuses and some selective colleges require **SAT Subject Tests. UC requires 2 tests in different subjects (if you chose Math, the UC's will only accept Math level II)**. Some selective independent colleges require 3 Subject Tests. Some majors have specific subject test requirements. We encourage you to take at least three subjects tests because UC will take your two highest scores. CSU's do not require SAT Subject Tests.
5. If you take the **ACT, University of California requires the optional Writing Exam.**
6. You will not be able to see the results of your test before you need to sign up for the next test.
7. Costs are listed in the registration forms. See Mr. Tenorio for fee waivers for testing, college apps, and AP Tests
8. **SAT's web site is [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com). ACT's web site is [www.act.org](http://www.act.org).** You can register online or by completing the form and mailing it. Tip booklets are available in the Career Center for these tests. Both SAT and ACT sell online courses at their website. We encourage you to use these websites for additional information.
9. **Whenever you register for tests, include Leland's High School Code (053091) because we will receive a report and stickers that will be placed on your testing record that is included with your transcript. Most schools still require scores to be officially sent from SAT or ACT.**
10. We encourage you to register early because testing spaces are limited in this area and many of our students have been assigned testing centers that are out of the area.
